

Fake Job/Educational Courses Offers

Indian Nationals/students are being targeted by fraudulent entities/individuals through calls/emails offering them jobs/educational courses in Finland and visa facilitation through unauthorized channels.

These entities often impersonate legitimate organizations like Embassy of India in Helsinki, Ministry of External Affairs, Embassy of Finland in New Delhi, Ministry of Employment in Finland or any other Government entities/organizations, promising guaranteed visas, educational courses, job placements, or other immigration-related services in exchange for personal information, payments, or other sensitive data.

Please be aware that these offers can be deceptive and may often lead to financial loss, identity theft, or other forms of exploitation. Please do verify the authenticity of the offer letter by contacting the respective companies/education institutions directly.
